Who is eligible?

Undergraduate and graduate students in German who will be enrolled in German courses in each of the fall and spring semesters 2016/2017.

- Undergraduate students must have completed at least six upper division units in German on campus with a minimum GPA of 3.25
- Graduate students must have completed at least six upper division/graduate units in German on campus with a minimum GPA of 3.50

Selection criteria:

A faculty committee will judge applications on the following criteria:

- Extent and quality of academic work accomplished
- GPA in the major
- Commitment and contributions to the Program
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident

How to apply:

Submit all information and the following documents to: sfsu.academicworks.com

1. An unofficial transcript;
2. One letter of recommendation included with the application;
3. A personal statement (not to exceed 200 words)

Application Deadline: May 8, 2016 by 11:59 p.m.

Half of the funds will be disbursed early in the Fall 2016 semester, the other half early in the Spring 2017 semester.
Please note: Federal and State regulations require that any scholarship/award/prize/loan be coordinated with students' financial aid awards.
